INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PART NUMBER: WR 233 WORX INTAKE GRATE YAMAHA 09 FZR, FZS

IMPORTANT: READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH INSTALLATION

Parts Supplied: 1 x Worx Intake Grate

- 1 Remove stock intake grate and wipe clean any old silicone or Loctite from hull and threaded inserts
- 2. Fill threaded inserts with silicone and apply a small amount of silicone to the front mounting surface and a generous amount of silicone to the rear mounting surface and edges of your new **Worx Intake Grate**
- 3. Fit **Worx** Intake Grate into position using the stock mounting bolts.
- 4 Wipe off excess silicone with a damp cloth. Allow 4-6 hours minimum for silicone to cure before riding.
- 5. Regularly check that all bolts are tight on your intake grate and ride plate.
- 6. Regularly check the condition of your intake grate after use.
