## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WORX DOMINATOR RIDE PLATE POLARIS OCTANE

**IMPORTANT:** 

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH INSTALLATION

Tools necessary for installation:

5mm Allen Key 1 x Tube of silicone

Parts Supplied:

1 x WORX Ride Plate

Fitting: Because the Octane boats are made individually in several different moulds there are minor differences in the position of the ride plate mounting holes. You may have to make some minor adjustments to the ride plate hole positions to make it fit your particular boat, we apologise for the inconvenience but it is something that is beyond our control

- Roll Ski onto side (refer to manufacturers instructions)
   Remove stock ride plate and wipe clean any old silicone from the hull and threaded inserts
- 2. Fill threaded inserts with silicone and apply a small amount of silicone to the mounting surfaces and around edges of your new Worx ride plate
- 3. Fit the Worx ride plate into position using the stock bolts and tighten.
- 4. Apply a bead of silicone around all edges of the ride plate and smooth off before it cures.
- 5. Wipe off excess silicone with a damp cloth. Allow 6-0 hours for the silicone to cure before riding
- 6 Regularly check that all bolts are tight
